The 9<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on Power-Line Communications and Its Applications (ISPLC 2005) will be held in **Vancouver, Canada from April 6 to 8, 2005**.

The symposium is centered around the general problem of communication over power lines. It focuses on the latest technological advances in power-line communications and current and future applications of power-line communication systems. The objective of the symposium is to bring together academia, industry, and standardization organizations and to stimulate research, development, and commercialization of power-line communication technology.

Prospective authors are invited to submit original contributions on all aspects of power-line communications, including, but not limited to:

- Channel Measurements and Modeling
- Standards and Regulations
- Electromagnetic Compatibility
- Information and Communication Theory
- Modulation and Coding Techniques
- OFDM and Spread Spectrum Techniques
- Detection and Iterative Processing Techniques
- Signal Processing
- Multiple-Access Techniques
- Modem and LSI Design
- Networks and Protocols
- System Architectures
- Applications and Services
- Experimental Systems and Field Trials

Papers will be reviewed on the basis of an extended abstract (not exceeding 3 pages) of sufficient detail to permit reasonable evaluation. The deadline for submission is **December 10, 2004**, with notification of decision by December 30, 2004. The cover page should include paper title, list of keywords indicating the paper's topic area, author's full names, affiliations and complete addresses, telephone numbers and e-mail addresses. The extended abstract must be submitted in PDF format.
